### 6.B. Initial 2024 Point In Time (PIT) Count Data

-San Leandro saw a 31% decrease in total homelessness from 2022 (n=409) to 2024 (n=283)

-Notably, the City's sheltered count decreased 42% from 2022 (n=97) to 2024 (n=56). This is likely a result from overcounting shelter beds from other Cities as part of San Leandro's total shelter bed count in 2019 and 2022.

-The City's unsheltered count decreased 27% between 2022 (n=312) and 2024 (n=227)
