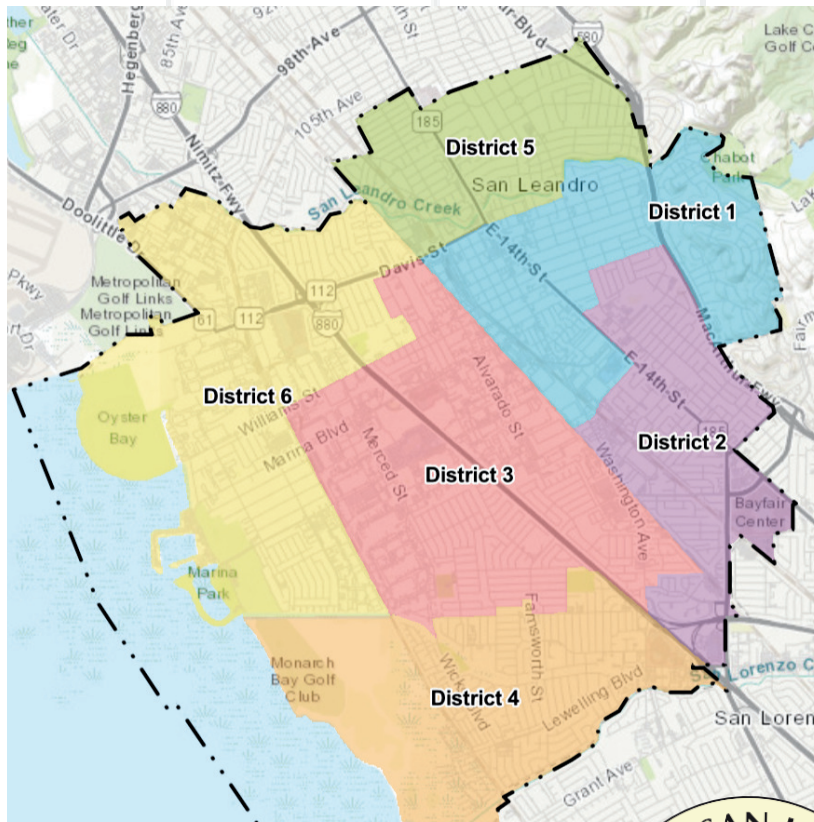
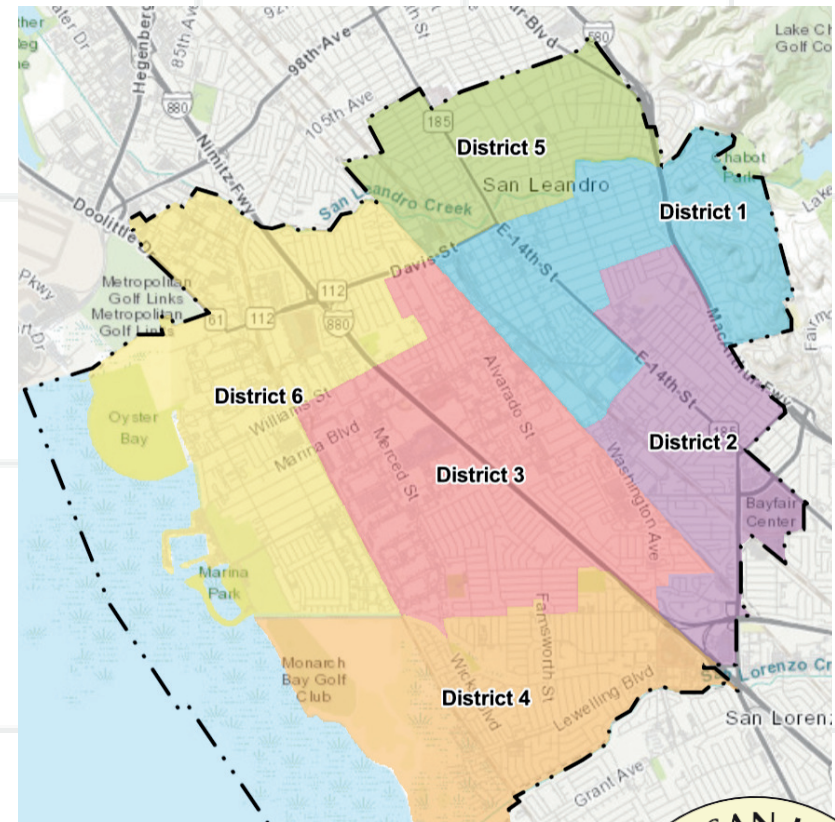

## CITY OF SAN LEANDRO DISTRICT-BASED VOTING

The City of San Leandro currently utilizes an at-large election system for the Mayor and City Council members. This means that the voters from the entire City choose the Mayor and six City Council members. A district-based election system is one in which the city is geographically divided into separate districts, each with one Council member who resides in the district and is chosen by the voters residing in that particular district.

In response to a demand letter based on the California Voting Rights Act, the San Leandro City Council voted to transition to a district-based election system beginning with the 2026 election cycle. Under the new system, the Mayor will continue to be elected at large but the six City Council members will be elected from districts.

The City of San Leandro currently utilizes an at-large election system for the Mayor and City Council members.
