San Leandro Manufacturing Month

WHEREAS, National Manufacturing Day is held on the first Friday in October to educate students, parents, and the public about the nature of modern manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Leandro recognizes and values the significance of manufacturing within our community; and

WHEREAS, approximately one-fifth of San Leandro's land is zoned for industrial use; and

WHEREAS, the manufacturing sector has been a vital contributor to the local economic welfare, and a pivotal part of San Leandro's business history for over 150 years; and

WHEREAS, today, more than 140 manufacturers, employing nearly 5,000 skilled workers and staff, operate in the City of San Leandro; and

WHEREAS, the regional organizations Bay Area Urban Manufacturing and SF Made host an East Bay Manufacturing Week in which the City of San Leandro participates annually; and


