
PROPOSED ESTUDILLO AVENUE CYCLE TRACK





COUNTYWIDE BIKEWAYS NETWORK


ESTUDILLO AVENUE IS PART OF

COLLISION HISTORY

- 2014-2024: 19 collisions total
 - 2 involved bicyclists and pedestrians
 - 1. 2002 hit and run at Estudillo/San Jose intersection
 - 2. 2019 pedestrian violation at Estudillo/Collier, nighttime and raining
- Both of these intersections will have RRFB's
- Most collisions occurred at the busy, signalized intersections of MacArthur Blvd. and Bancroft Ave. and not within the bike lanes themselves.
