

### Contract Amendment and Cost Savings

- Flock Safety notified the San Leandro Police Department of ALPR camera price increases impacting future camera purchases and the cost to our existing 41 cameras, following the termination of the original CSA on June 30, 2024.
- Flock Safety offered the City of San Leandro a cost savings by extending the CSA by five years.
  - \$2,500.00 vs. \$3,000.00 per camera.
  - \$41,000.00 annual savings per year.
  - \$205,000.00 over the five-year term for 82 ALPR Cameras.
- On-going annual costs are estimated to not exceed \$210,000.00.

#### Success Stories

- **February 2023** Flock used in a bank robbery investigation. During the investigation, detectives learned OPD was also investigating a series of bank robberies. Detectives used Flock and learned the same getaway vehicle was used on other bank robberies. Based on this information, detectives were able to identify a suspect and link him to five bank robberies.
- June 2023- Flock footage used to locate suspect vehicle in a homicide investigation.
- June 2023- Officers used Flock to locate an armed robbery suspect vehicle. This led to pursuit, standoff, and eventual arrest of suspect.
- June 2023- Detectives utilized Flock database search using only a vehicle color and description to find a carjacking vehicle based on time and location of footage. Investigation led the arrest of suspect.
- **September 2023-** Officers located an armed carjacking vehicle after receiving a Flock hit and arrested the driver.
