

# COMMUNITY FOOD SERVICES (CFS)

FUNDING UPDATE



## CFS Background:

- Covid era: increased demand of food providers services
- Additional funding (American Rescue Program Act [ARPA]) supported providers to meet increased demand
- ARPA funding is now exhausted, yet no decline in community need and provider demand
- Several food providers/non profits came to the City to seek additional funds
- Creation of one-time CFS funding in addition to increased funding for FY26 and FY27 Community Assistance Program (CAP)

Announced October 2024, this one-time funding made available **\$200,000** in General Funds for food services and activities that serve moderate to low-income members of our community.

<b>Boys &amp; Girls Club of San Leandro</b>	Food pantry, launching edible garden, youth nutrition education workshops, meals for low income youth serving approximately <b>50 youth per day.</b>	<b>\$19,000</b>
<b>Mercy Retirement and Care Center</b>	Grocery distribution twice a month for low income seniors at 8 locations in San Leandro, serving approximately <b>1,107 individuals per year.</b>	<b>\$18,000</b>
<b>Spectrum Community Services</b>	Hot nutritious meals in a communal setting serving <b>450 low income seniors per year.</b>	<b>\$18,000</b>

<b>Tiburcio Vasquez Health Center</b>	CalFresh and WIC enrollment, food distribution, community cooking classes serving approximately <b>6,000 San Leandro residents per year.</b>	<b>\$17,000</b>
<b>Korean Community Center of the East Bay</b>	Culturally resonant hot meals delivered to low income, highly-isolated seniors with mobility challenges, <b>serving 55 San Leandro seniors per year.</b>	<b>\$17,000</b>
<b>Vietnamese American Community Center of the East Bay</b>	Hot meals, grocery assistance, wellness check-ins, wellness education workshops and comprehensive wrap-around services serving <b>35 San Leandro residents per year.</b>	<b>\$17,000</b>
<b>San Lorenzo Family Help Center</b>	Food recovery program, food pantry and expansion of mobile food pantry serving <b>3500 San Leandro individuals and families per year.</b>	<b>\$16,000</b>
<b>Bridging Grace</b>	Grocery delivery for low-income and homebound families, serving <b>11 San Leandro families per year.</b>	<b>\$15,000</b>
