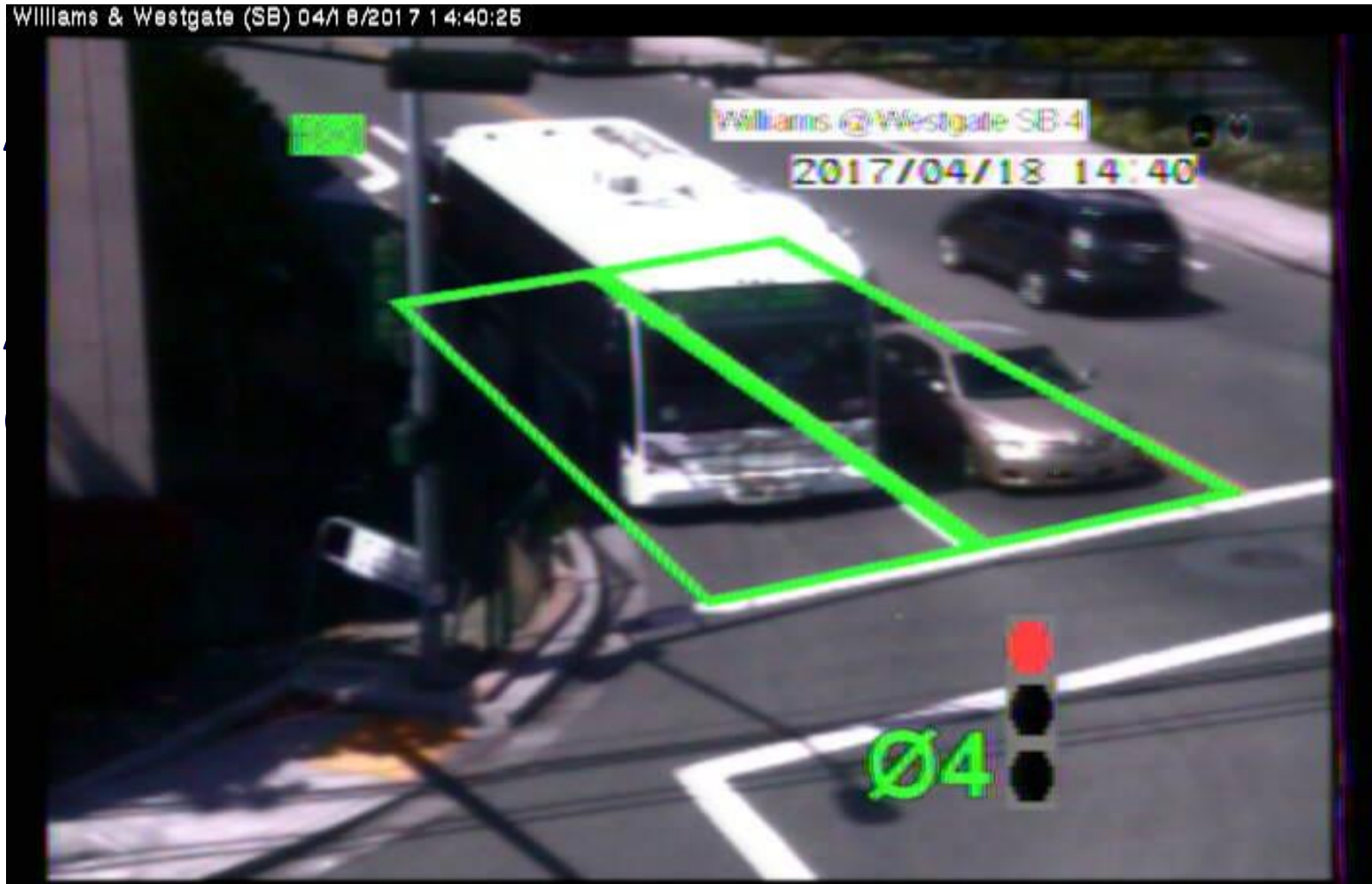

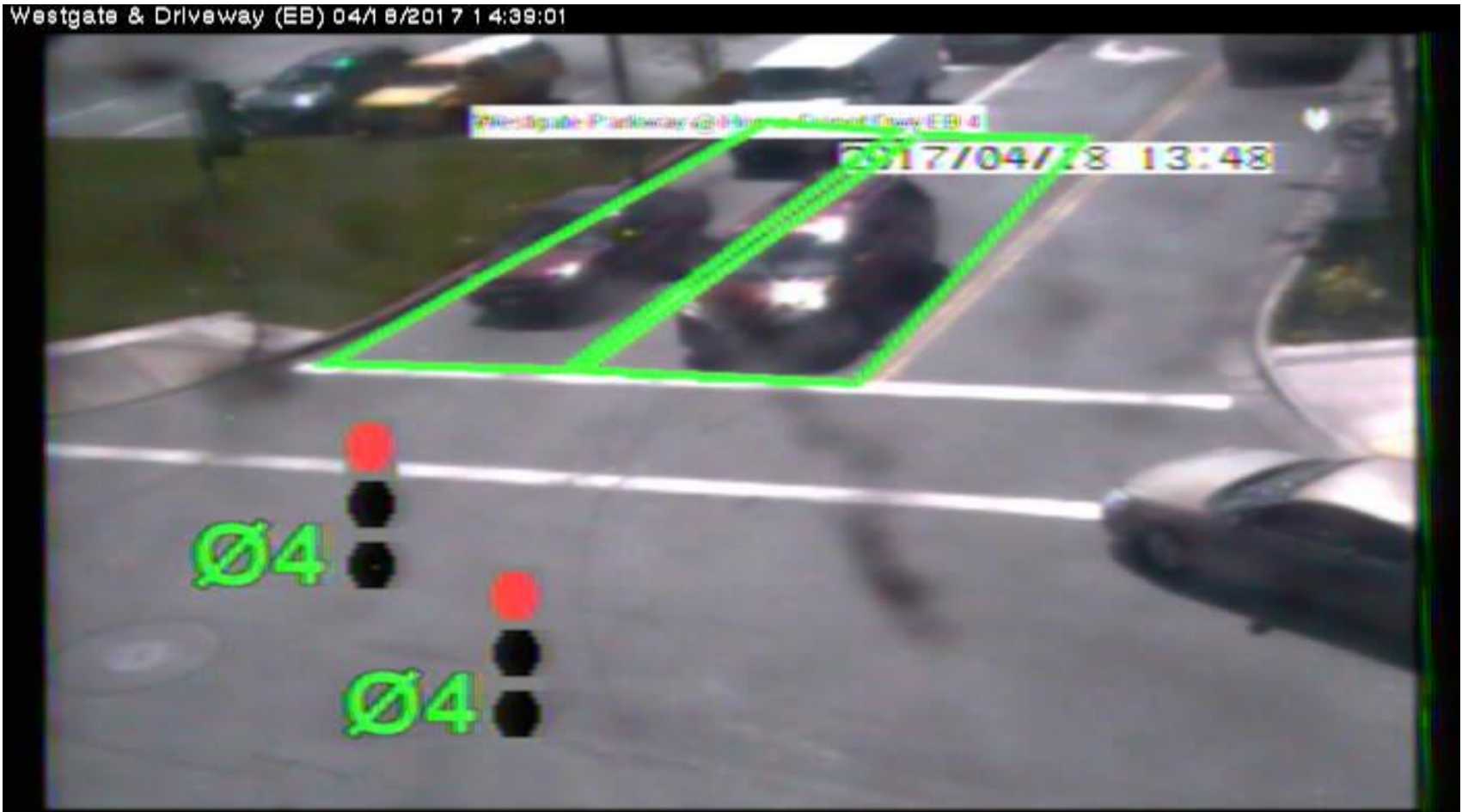

# SLPD

- 8 automatic license plate readers
- 92 AXON body cameras
- 17 CCTV
  - Throughout public safety building and jail
- 5 Red Light Cameras
- 2 Watch guard cameras
  - On jail van and rescue vehicle
- Total: 124

# SLPD Camera recording policies

- CCTV cameras
  - Routine recorded video - minimum of 90 days.
  - Jail video and video of evidentiary value will be secured and maintained for 1 year and will be deleted unless the video footage is retained as part of a police investigation, claim filed, pending litigation, criminal proceeding, or alleged misconduct (Government Code 34090.6).

# SLPD Camera recording policies

- Portable Audio Video Recorders (Body Cameras)
  - In accordance with Policy 426
  - Any Recording media which has been placed into safekeeping shall be retained for a period of no less than 180 days or until the related matter has been closed (e.g. internal investigation, civil litigation).

# REDFLEX Red Light Cameras Contract
