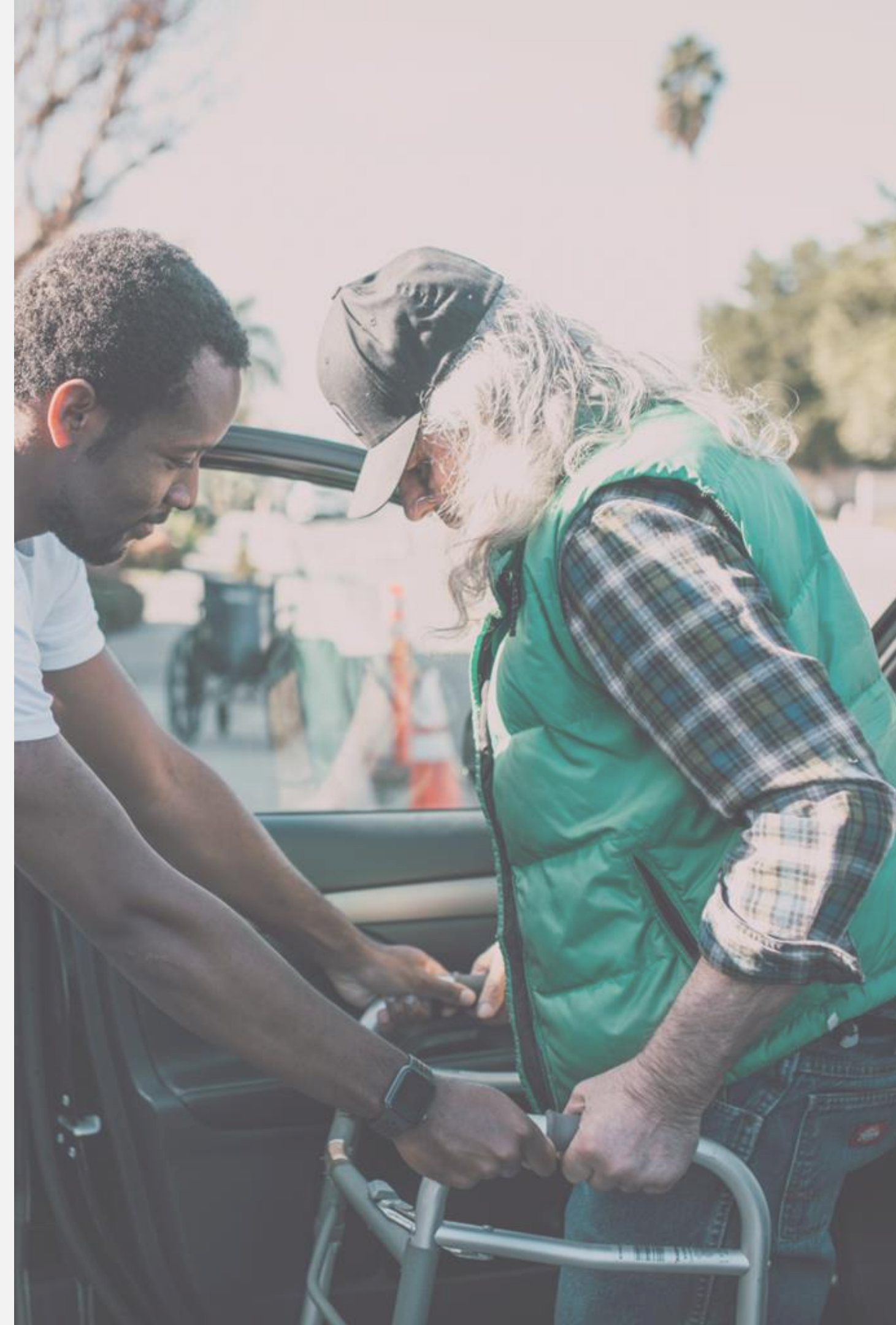

Human Services Department

The Department has 9.0 FTE equivalent (2.0 vacant positions) who administer the following core services in the community.

SENIOR SERVICES

- Fund and coordinate Paratransit services and food access programs
- Coordinate classes, activities and events for 50+
- Implement the Age-Friendly Action Plan
- Senior Commission

Community Outreach and Support

- Coordinate homeless outreach
- Fund 24/7 domestic violence outreach program
- Fund and administer Alternative Response Unit
- Serve as information and referral hub
- Administer competitive grant funding
- Human Services Commission

HOMELESSNESS RESPONSE

- Fund shelter services (San Leandro Shelter, Sister Me Home)
- Manage Lewelling Interim Housing Day-time Drop-in Center
- Coordinate Winter Shelter program
- Manage Homelessness Prevention Rental Assistance program
- Coordinate and collaborate with local and regional partners

Challenges

- **Our community's needs are expanding and diversifying**
- **Nonprofit partners are stretched thin**
 - Increase in need for services
 - Fiscal sustainability
 - Talent retention
- **Physical space for services**
 - Nonprofits growing out of their existing spaces, looking to expand and grow
 - Need space for Winter Shelters, interim housing, Safe Parking, and deeply affordable housing
