

**AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE  
DECLARATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF  
EMERGENCY SERVICES OF THE CITY OF  
SAN LEANDRO SUSPENDING  
ENFORCEMENT OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS  
IN LAND USE PERMITS AND APPROVALS  
AND ZONING AND ENCROACHMENT  
REQUIREMENTS IN THE SAN LEANDRO  
MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED TO THE  
COVID-19 RELIEF TEMPORARY OUTDOOR  
FACILITIES PROGRAM**

The Declaration of the Director of Emergency Services of the City of San Leandro Suspending Enforcement of Certain Provisions in Land Use Permits and Approvals and Zoning and Encroachment Requirements in the San Leandro Municipal Code related to the COVID-19 Relief Temporary Outdoor Facilities Program, dated June 17, 2020 is hereby amended pursuant to the authority of City Manager, Jeff Kay, as Director of Emergency Services.


The effective date of the Declaration shall be amended so as remove the ending date of December 31, 2020, or the termination of the local state of emergency, whichever occurs first, and to extend through the end of the local state of emergency, to state:

*This regulation shall remain in effective the termination of the local state of emergency; or as otherwise terminated, modified or extended by the San Leandro City Council.*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeff Kay, as Director of Emergency Services, declare that this regulation shall become effective as of 12:01 a.m. on December 16, 2020 and remain in effect until the termination of the local state of emergency; or as otherwise terminated, modified or extended by the San Leandro City Council; and

I DECLARE, any violation of this regulation shall be subject to enforcement and penalty as provided under San Leandro Municipal Code Chapter 1-12.
