About

On August 24, 2014 at 3:20am a magnitude 6.0 earthquake struck the northern San Francisco Bay Area, lasting ~ 15 seconds.

Largest earthquake to hit the Bay Area in 25 years since Loma Prieta.

Napa and Solano Counties damages estimate - \$400 million.

Lessons Learned

Before:

Develop

- Policies that support EP
- Hazards Survey
- All Hazards EOPs / Recovery Plans
- Plan for impromptu volunteers or donations
- Hazard specific public educational campaigns on preventable incidents/injuries
- Know your community partners

During:

- Communication issues
- Community, city employees, CalOES and mutual aid agencies showing up to help*
- Delayed FEMA support and struggling individuals / business

After:

- Establish and maintain a lessons learned and improvement program
- Work with community partner's to resolve identified
