Gloria Kim shared Recreation division updates as summer kicks off, noting that the San Leandro Family Aquatic Center opened Memorial Day weekend and has already welcomed nearly 600 visitors. The Cherry Festival is this Saturday, the 6th, with the parade including 58 participating groups and vehicles, and upcoming events include a free outdoor movie night on June 13 and a July 4th 250th celebration at Monarch Bay Golf Club from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Jennifer Auletta reported updates from the Parks and Urban Forestry division,

including the installation of new shade sails at Marina Park and continued progress on the fitness court, with concrete work beginning this month and a grand opening planned for September. Golf course contract work will begin soon, featuring improvements to the 9-hole course and a newly named restaurant, The Landing at Monarch Bay, pending kitchen equipment before unveiling its menu. Additional turf reduction projects at Davis and Warden and Halcyon Park are also scheduled before the end of the fiscal year.
