

Proclamation Honoring Moira Fry, Loyal Community Servant

WHEREAS, Moira Fry was born in St. Louis Missouri; and

WHEREAS, Moira Fry worked at Project Eden as a drug counselor in the 1970s. She was also the first woman at PG&E to be promoted to Electric Construction Supervisor in 1987; and

WHEREAS, Moira Fry and her husband moved to San Leandro in 1991 and their son was born in 1992 and raised in the community. Moira was involved in chaperoning school field trips, supervising school events, helping with the little league, and contributed to charitable causes; and

WHEREAS, Moira Fry began working with April Showers in 2008, a non-profit that helps homeless individuals by providing dignity and resources. Moira volunteered to help with housing homeless people who were living in San Leandro, and provided advice to our Homeless Compact Program; and

WHEREAS, Moira Fry works with Building Futures for Women and Children and our local warming shelter to aid homeless people in the area. She also served on the Board of the Estudillo Estates Neighborhood Association, and on the Board of Directors for the San Leandro Community Food Pantry; and

WHEREAS, Moira Fry and her husband own BDM Electric, and she still volunteers to help others. Moira Fry shares a vision for increasing coordinated response plans to help our most vulnerable community members and supports the goal of creating a navigation center in San Leandro.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Mayor Pauline Russo Cutter do hereby celebrate, honor, and thank Moira Fry for her many years of outstanding service to the San Leandro community.
