ARPA Overview

- \$18.6 million in ARPA allocations (received in full)
- Funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024
- Funds must be spent by December 31, 2026
- Limited uses
 - Responding to the public health and negative economic impacts of the pandemic
 - Providing premium pay to essential workers
 - o Providing government services to the extent of revenue loss due to the pandemic
 - o Making necessary investments in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure
 - Disaster Relief (ARPA Flex)
 - Surface transportation (ARPA Flex)
 - Community Development Block Grants (ARPA Flex)



Spending Categories - City Examples

REVENUE REPLACEMENT

- \$10M with no calculations
- Provision of Government Services

RESPONDING TO THE PANDEMIC

- Homelessness outreach
- Community Development Projects

ARPA FLEX

- Disaster Relief
- Surface transportation
