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Lien Process Highlights

Initial Billing

Property incurs initial charge for service or violation through issuing City Department. An invoice is sent by Finance. Staff work with customers on questions and potential options.

Legal Notice

The legal notice of the public hearing is published twice in the local paper. Affected customers receive three notices of intent to lien along with a copy of public hearing details.

Monthly Statements

2

Statements are sent monthly following the initial invoice. Finance works with customers and departments in attempts to resolve outstanding balances.

After proper noticing, City Council holds public hearing generally 2nd Council meeting in July (This year public hearing will be held July 21 st).

Tax Lien

Collection/Compliance efforts continue by staff through end of July. Outstanding balances are submitted to County for assessment on property tax by County's deadline in early August.


*Amounts reflect balances as of July 8, 2025. Continued collection efforts will continue through end of July and only unresolved balances will be submitted to the County for lien assessment.
