



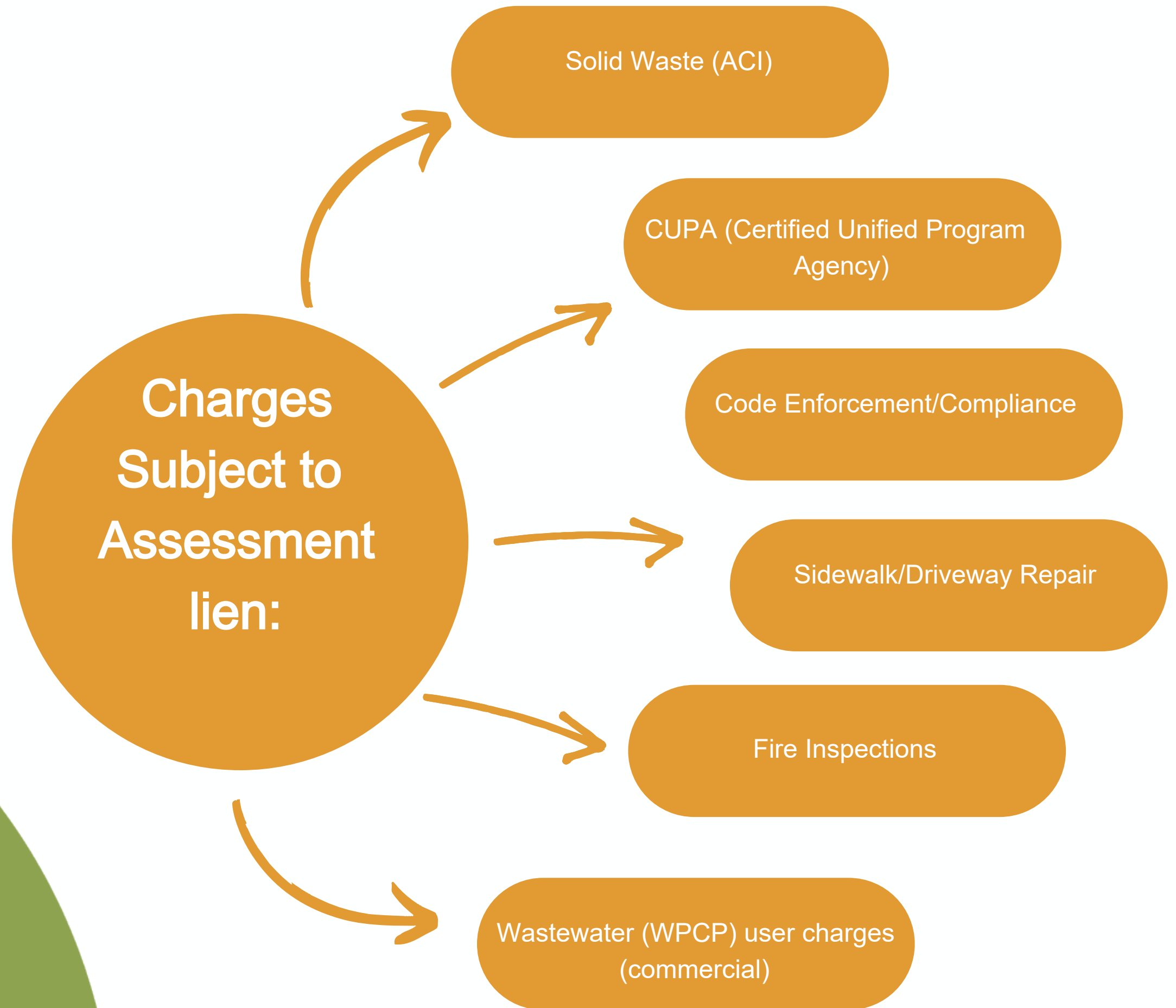
# CITY OF SAN LEANDRO ANNUAL LIENS 2025 -26

City Council

the property tax bill.

related to public  
safety and allow City  
an effective way to  
ensure fiscal  
accountability.



# Lien Process Highlights

## Initial Billing

Property incurs initial charge for service or violation through issuing City Department. An invoice is sent by Finance. Staff work with customers on questions and potential options.

## Legal Notice

The legal notice of the public hearing is published twice in the local paper. Affected customers receive three notices of intent to lien along with a copy of public hearing details.

## Tax Lien

Collection/Compliance efforts continue by staff through end of July. Outstanding balances are submitted to County for assessment on property tax by County's deadline in early August.

## Monthly Statements

Statements are sent monthly following the initial invoice. Finance works with customers and departments in attempts to resolve outstanding balances.

## Public Hearing

After proper noticing, City Council holds public hearing generally 2<sup>nd</sup> Council meeting in July (This year public hearing will be held July 21<sup>st</sup>).
