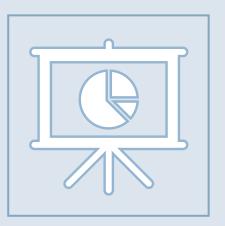

City Council Priority Work Session February 1, 2025



Council ranked priorities for the top three priority areas of focus:

- Infrastructure received seven votes from Council as a priority area
- Streets and roads a specific focus



- Proposal to implement a policy to allocate year-end unspent funds to streets and road repair
- No formal action was taken to implement this proposed policy
