**Republican majority** with **53R** – **45D** – **2 Ind**

Majority Leader John Thune (R – SD)

Minority Leader Chuck Schumer (D – NY)

# Legislative Branch

## **US Senator Alex Padilla**

- Senior Senator appointed 2021 and elected 2022
- Committees: EPW, ENR, Judiciary, Budget, Rules

## **US Senator Adam Schiff**

- Junior Senator elected 2024
- Committees: EPW, Agriculture, Judiciary, Small Business

## **US Representative Lateefah Simon**

- Representative elected 2024
- Committees: Oversight & Government Reform, Small Business

# Legislative Agenda

## Budget and Appropriations FY 2026

- Minibus resolved funding for 3 spending bills until Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>  
Agriculture, Military Construction-VA, Legislative Branch
- Continuing Resolution expires Jan. 30<sup>th</sup> for other 9 bills  
CJS, Defense, Energy-Water, Financial Services, Homeland Security,  
**Interior-Environment**, Labor-HHS-Ed, State, T-HUD
- Resolution on Community Project Funding request for Shoreline

## FY 2027

- Submission of new requests for Community Project Funding

# Legislative Agenda (cont'd)

## Urgent Business

- Addressing **healthcare** subsidies and other reforms
- Reconciling the House and Senate versions of **housing** bills
- Drafting the next **surface transportation** reauthorization

## Considerations

- Anticipating **midterm elections** may complicate ability to reach agreements to pass consequential legislation
- Recognizing the **low productivity** of the first session of the 119<sup>th</sup> Session of Congress
