## Mayor's Compensation

- Pursuant to the City Council Handbook -- Appendix A, "Guidelines Regarding the Setting of the Mayor's Salary"
  - The base salary for the Mayor shall be two (2) times the amount paid to City Council.
  - A full-time Mayor may receive a salary of up to three (3) times the amount paid to City Council.
    - The Mayor shall submit in writing a personally composed statement requesting such increase and justifying the request.

### Statute

San Leandro City Charter Section 255 provides for the compensation of City Council members: "All provisions of the <u>Government Code</u> of the State of California relating to compensation, benefits and reimbursement for expenses applicable to members of a City Council of a general law city shall be applicable to Council Members."

Subsection (a)(2) of Cal. Govt. Code section 36516 thus applies to how salaries are set for San Leandro City Councilmembers. For cities with a population of between 75,000 - 150,000, this subsection authorizes compensation of up to \$1900 per month.

- → The amount of compensation is authorized by SB 239, which was enacted earlier this year.
- → Salary increases may not take effect until after at least one member of the council commences a new term (i.e. January 2025).

Government Code Section 36516(a)(4) allows compensation to be increased above \$1900 per month in the future, but the amount of the increase shall not exceed the greater of either of the following: 1) an amount equal to 5 percent for each calendar year from the operative date of the last adjustment of the salary in effect when the ordinance or amendment is enacted, or 2) an amount equal to inflation since January 1, 2024, based upon the California Consumer Price Index, which shall not exceed 10 percent for each calendar year.

## Monthly Salary Options

- Increase for Council effective January 1, 2025
- Eligibility for a maximum monthly compensation of \$1,900 per month

# Timing of Compensation Increase

### City Council:

 Council salary increases may not take effect until after at least one member of the council commences a new term in January 2025.

### Mayor:

 The Mayor may submit a request to the Rules Committee and the Rules Committee may consider a request by the Mayor after the first year of the Mayor's term in office.

#### Council Handbook Language:

• Councilmember compensation is subject to an annual review and re-evaluation.



## Direction Needed

1. Revise Council Handbook to align with post election cycle review.

 Bring an ordinance in December 2023 to increase compensation by a specified amount for implementation in January 2025.
