



Proclamation

SEPTEMBER 17 - 23, 2023, AS CONSTITUTION WEEK

WHEREAS, September 17, 2023, marks the 236th anniversary of the signing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution's preamble perfectly presents its grand goals: to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution embodies the vision that power should be balanced, be it between the branches of government, between the federal government and state governments, or between the interests of government and the rights of individuals; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this historic document and its memorable anniversary; and to the patriotic celebrations that commemorate the occasion.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Juan González III, Mayor of the City of San Leandro, do hereby proclaim September 17 through 23 as "**CONSTITUTION WEEK**" in the City of San Leandro, and encourage local residents to reflect on the privileges, rights, and responsibilities that the Constitution bestows.
