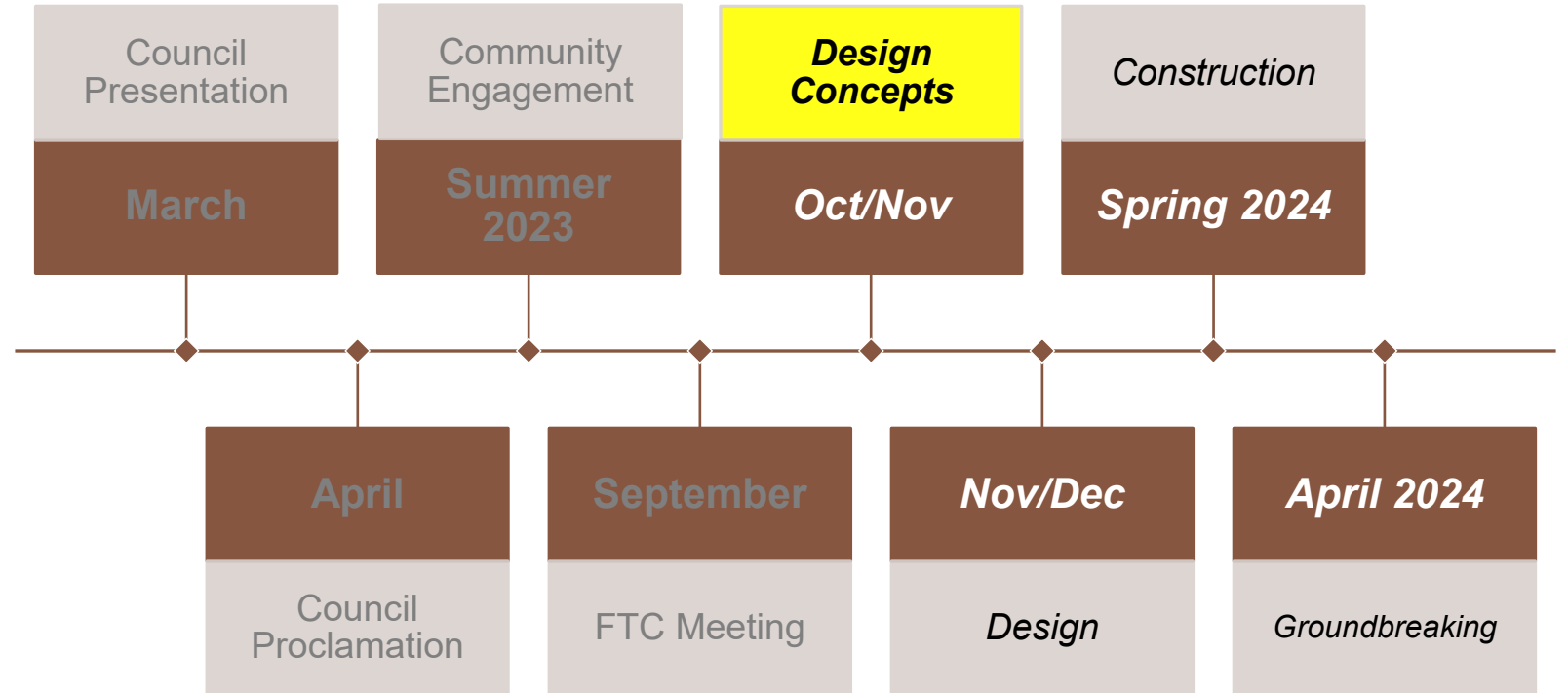

The City of San Leandro is looking for the public's ideas on the design of the planned Marina Park memorial to Steven Taylor and others who have lost their lives due to police action.

The first in a series of public meetings to review designs was held Saturday, July 8 at the San Leandro

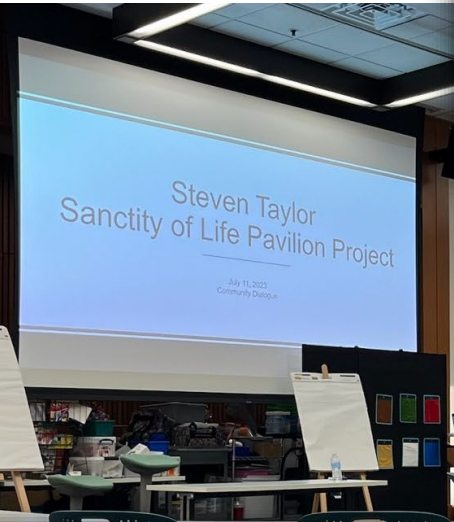

Taylor was shot and killed by San Leandro police officer Jason Fletcher in 2020 after employees called police as Taylor was wielding a metal baseball bat at the Walmart on Hesperian Boulevard. Fletcher has since left the police department and was charged

with voluntary manslaughter, to which he plead not guilty, and is facing trial.

The City Council voted to set up the Steven Taylor Sanctity of Life Memorial following a public outcry after Taylor's death. Calls for a memorial had come from, among others, Taylor's grandmother Addie Kitchen and the Justice For Steven Taylor group, see MEMORIAL, page 5
