## Background on AB1616

#### Types of products allowed

- baked goods (without cream, custard or meat fillings);
- candy, such as brittle and toffee;
- chocolate-covered nuts or dried fruit;
- dried fruit;
- dry baking mixes;
- fruit pies, fruit empanadas and fruit tamales;
- granola, cereals, and trail mixes;
- honey and sweet sorghum (molasses) syrup;
- certain jams, jellies, preserves and fruit butters;
- nut mixes and nut butters;
- popcorn;
- vinegar and mustard;
- roasted coffee and dried tea; and
- waffle cones and pizzelles

## **Zoning Code Changes**

- Adds Cottage Food Operations in Article 3
   Definitions
- Creates a new section in Article 16 for Cottage Food Operations
- Allows for an Administrative Exception
- Creates parking requirement of one space for Cottage Food Operation employee

#### Cottage Food Operations (CFO) Regulations

- 1. 150 foot separation between CFOs, along frontage
- 2. 32 foot across front of parcel for parking
- 3. Parking and circulation plan
- 4. Noise control to 55 dBl
- 5. Limitation to small trucks, only
- 6. Garage maintained for parking
- 7. Commercial vehicle parked out of public view

Above standards will not apply to cases where no at-home sales are proposed.

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council:

Take public testimony on the proposed Zoning Code Amendments;

Adopt the Ordinance approving the Zoning Code Amendments related to Cottage Food Operations
