- ▶ HAM Radio Certification Class




PUBLIC OUTREACH

YOUR ROLE IN AN EMERGENCY

Pre Emergency

- ▶ Help organize and prepare the community
- ▶ Prepare your home and family
- ▶ Train IS 100, 200, 700 and 800
- ▶ Attend an EOC exercise or drill to understand your roll

During an Emergency

- ▶ Work with PIO team to receive most up to date information, and provide information from constituents
- ▶ Understand the objective of the incident
- ▶ Work with City Management Team to understand what proclamations may be needed.

Post Emergency

- ▶ Continue to provide constituents with information from PIO team about the status of recovery.
- ▶ Assist emergency management team with pushing information about local, state and federal assistance for constituents.
