# FY 2018-2019 Annual Action Plan CDBG Highlights

- ➤ HUD FY18-19 allocations for CDBG and HOME were received on May 1, 2018. They were approximately 8% higher than last year's allocation (from \$659,582 to \$714,909)
- ➤ Additionally, staff identified \$29,918 in unused prior year CDBG grant funds that will be carried forward to the FY18-19
- ➤ The following slides describe how the increased allocation was distributed among the CDBG funded programs:
  - Public Services
  - General Administration
  - Housing Services
  - Capital Improvements
