RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN LEANDRO CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE THE SAN LEANDRO CROSSTOWN CORRIDORS STUDY

WHEREAS, the City Council has indicated that streets are a critical component of the City's infrastructure and their condition is an important factor in the quality of life for the residents and the vitality of local businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant; and

WHEREAS, City staff worked with a traffic engineering consultant, Fehr & Peers, who conducted multiple efforts of community engagement and outreach; and

WHEREAS, the plan was developed with a stakeholder group that included representatives from the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee and Engineering & Transportation Departments as well as regional transit partners and bike and environmental advocacy groups; and

WHEREAS, the project team developed the City's Vision Zero Policy for traffic safety impacts for the health and comfort of all those who live and travel in the City of San Leandro and the implementation of this plan is a step towards making the transportation system safer and more equitable for users of all transportation modes; and

WHEREAS, the Crosstown Corridors Study will serve as a framework for the City to identify, analyze, and prioritize safety improvements on local streets and will render the City eligible for future funds; and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2022, City staff and consultants presented the Crosstown Class IV Corridors Study to the City Council Facilities and Transportation Committee and received the Committee's feedback.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of San Leandro City Council does **RESOLVE** that:

The above recitals are true and correct and have served as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council hereby approves the Crosstown Corridors Study and authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, to implement the plan.
