Staffing Grant Community Policing Grant

CURRENT COPS GRANT-CHP 2011

- City was funded for a three year staffing grant in 2011
- Total grant funds awarded was \$2.2 million
- Started drawing down a portion of the grant in Nov 2010
- Obligated to maintain CHP 5 positions for one year, beyond the 3 years
- Program Funds will be exhausted by Dec 2013



CURRENT COPS GRANT CHP 2011

Current Grant expires July 1, 2015 for the following positions:

Grant outcomes:

- Increased Crime Free program participation and reduced crime in Mulit-housing complexes
- Additional School Resource Officers expanded school/ police intervention and prevention activities
- Street Team expanded enfrocement with violent crimes, gangs and ABC enforcement
- Downtown Bike Officer program expanded coverage to 7 days a week focusing on safety and quality of life issues downtown, including issues related to homeless and soliciting



2013 COPS Hiring Program (CHP) FAQ's

- Grant must be submitted by May 22, 2013
- May receive up to 75 percent of the approved entry-level officer salary and benefit costs, with a minimum 25 percent local cash match requirement and a maximum federal share of \$125,000 per officer position over a three-year grant period.



2013 COPS Hiring Program (CHP) FAQ's

- Must maintain the position for 1 year after the 36 month grant
- Grants hiring military veterans and cities with a homicide or gun violence problem will receive additional consideration.
- Grants requesting School Resource Officers will receive additional consideration (Must have an MOU in place at time of grant request)
- Can not change problem area post-award
- San Leandro could receive a maximum of 4 CHP positions (eligible to request 5 % over current sworn positions)



2013 COPS Hiring Program (CHP) FAQ's

- This year the cap on funding will allow more agencies to be funded
- We can apply if we have a current grant, but CHP funded positions <u>MUST</u> be over and above the number of officers funded in budget
- Can not use grant to fund final year of 2011 CHP



CHP Grantee Costs

• The fiscal impact per position :

Per Officer Position	Top Step Salary/ Benefits	x 4 year grant commitment	Grant value	Net Cost to city over 4 years
1 officer	\$168,000	\$672,000	-\$125,000	=\$547,000

- Grant cost to city break down:
 - > \$126,334 per year (years 1-3) and
 - > \$168,000 year 4
 - > Approx. total: \$547,000



Community Policing Development (CPD) Program

Grant Purpose: To advance the practice of community policing in law enforcement agencies through:

- Training and technical assistance,
- The development and documentation of innovative community policing strategies,
- Best practices that are national in scope
- 2 Year Grant, max \$50K, no local match



SLPD Crime Initiative "United for Safety"

- Citywide safety campaign
- Focusing on:
 - Community engagement
 - "Whether you work, live, or play in this city; you have a role in public safety"
- Goal is to educate and unite our community to create a safer city

SLPD Crime Initiative "United for Safety"

Grant would fund:

- Smartphone application for police services
- Program Marketing
- Partnership to develop residential surveillance camera program
- Virtual neighbor watch groups





Options for CHP 2013 Grant

- 1. Apply for CHP 2013 grant requesting 2 Officer positions under veterans preference program. Positions could partially fund current grant positions which expire in 2015 and may otherwise be eliminated.
- Apply for School Resource Officer Grant, offsetting position costs with contribution from School District
- 3. Decline consideration for COPS CHP 2013 staffing grant
