

District Elections - Welcome

Background

The City of San Leandro has entered into a written agreement with a prospective plaintiff to extend the Safe Harbor period pur the California Voting Rights Act (CVRA) on behalf of San Leandro resident Robert Bulatao. The notice of CVRA violation asserte for Council unlawfully dilutes the voting power of Asian Americans.

The City Council initiated the move to district elections on January 6, 2025, when it passed a resolution directing City staff to for adopting by district elections for Council using the current district maps that were adopted in 2022. Under the agreement legislation establishing San Leandro's six Council districts must be adopted by July 5, 2025.

District Elections

The City of San Leandro, like hundreds of cities and school districts across the state, is making a change in how voters elect i vote for one Council Member who lives in their district. This will replace the current system of at-large elections.
