What is the HUD Consolidated Plan?



- ➤ Five-Year Strategic Plan (Con Plan) mandated by HUD to be eligible to receive annual CDBG funds
 - (July 1, 2020 June 30, 2025)
 - City Council approved in May 2020
- ➤ Identifies long-term housing & community development needs
- Establishes strategies for addressing these priority needs
- Sets performance goals to measure success
- Determines priorities for the City's federal CDBG & HOME funding programs

What is the HUD Consolidated Plan?



- > Annual Action Plan
 - Describes CDBG & HOME funding allocations and strategies to implement Five-Year Con Plan for the coming year
 - > Required submittal to HUD to receive annual entitlement grant
- Consolidated Annual Performance & Evaluation Report (CAPER)
 - Assesses the City's performance in meeting the goals, objectives and action proposed under its HUD-approved Annual Action Plan

DRAFT FY 2023-2024 Annual Action Plan CDBG Highlights

- > FY 2023-24 represents the fourth year of the HUD Five-year FY 2020-24 Consolidated Plan
- > FY 2023-24 notification of allocation received in early March:
 - > CDBG: \$808,949
 - **HOME:** \$238,909
- ➤ Community Assistance Grant Program (CAP) 2 Year FY23-25 CAP and CDBG Public Services funding will be reviewed by Human Services Commission on March 22, 2023
 - > CAP grantee recommendations will be forwarded by Human Services Department to Council for the May 1 public hearing

What is the CDBG Program?



- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
 - Housing and Community Development Act of 1974
 - Purpose: provide decent, affordable housing, suitable living environment, and expansion of economic opportunity
 - Activities must meet at least one of three national objectives:
 - > 1. Benefit to low and moderate income people
 - > 2. Aid in prevention of slum and blight
 - > 3. Urgent need
 - Flexible grant for a broad range of activities: housing, capital improvements, public services, economic development, & general administration
 - > San Leandro = CDBG entitlement jurisdiction

What is the HOME Program?



- ➤ Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME)
 - > 1990 Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act
 - Similar to CDBG in flexibility and emphasis on local needs, but for affordable housing activities only
 - San Leandro receives annual HOME funds through the Alameda County HOME Consortium
