SLPD staff learned that the driver of a vehicle suffered a medical emergency while driving and was incapacitated, causing his vehicle to be uncontrolled as it rolled through the intersection.

You, Stephon Jackson, recognized the danger, put the runaway vehicle in park, turned it off, and then comforted an infant found in the back seat, all before emergency medical personnel could arrive. Your swift actions prevented what was a tragic incident already from multiplying. More so, your act of comforting an infant is why the City of San Leandro is also known as the city where kindness matters.
