**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE
AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF 9-1-1 CALLS BETWEEN ALAMEDA COUNTY
SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND SAN LEANDRO POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, 9-1-1 is the nationally recognized telephone number for the public to report police, fire, or medical emergencies; and

WHEREAS, 9-1-1 calls made within the geographical boundaries of the City of San Leandro are received by the San Leandro Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the San Leandro Police Department's Communications Center serves as the City's primary public safety answering point; and

WHEREAS, due to staffing constraints, the San Leandro Police Department desires to contract the transfer of all 9-1-1 and non-emergency calls to the Alameda County Sheriff's Office between the hours of 11:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M., seven (7) days per week; and

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Sheriff's Office agrees to accept all 9-1-1 and non-emergency calls from San Leandro Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the agreement to transfer calls began on March 10, 2024 and will expire on September 9, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Leandro does **RESOLVE** that the agreement for the transfer of 9-1-1 and non-emergency calls between the Alameda County Sheriff's Office and the San Leandro Police Department is hereby approved and execution by the City Manager, including any retroactive actions or activities necessary to effect the intent of this Resolution, is authorized.
