
Accessible Voting Locations (AVLs)


In response to COVID-19, as mandated by the State, every eligible voter will be mailed a ballot and provided in-person voting opportunities for the November 3, 2020 General Election.











# Accessible Voting Locations (AVL)

1 Location per 10,000 Voters

# 4 Locations March 3, 2020 November 3, 2020

- Any voter can vote at any location
  - Electronic Poll Book
- Provide the same voting services as the ROV
  - Ballot On Demand Printing
  - Voter Information Guide On Demand Printing
- 100 locations required throughout the County
- Open Four days up to and including Election Day
- PPE required by the State
- Physical distancing required (6ft)
- 18 required to staff Location
  - 1 ROV Staff member
  - 17 Election Workers

### 24 Hour Official Ballot Drop Boxes

1 Drop Box per 15,000 Voters

#### 28 Drop Boxes

November 2018


#### **66 Drop Boxes**

November 2020



- Ballots will be retrieved every 24 hours
- Vote by mail voters who do not want to mail in their ballot can drop their voted ballots off at these drop-off sites
- 2 Ballot retrievers are required and must adhere to proper physical distancing and safety requirements
