RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE 2019
DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ) EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) AWARD IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$29,997.90 AND TO APPROPRIATE THESE FUNDS INTO ACCOUNT 150-21-063

**WHEREAS**, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance (JAG) Grant Program is the leading source of federal funding for criminal justice initiatives at the state and local levels, and is administered by the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the JAG program supports a broad range of state and local projects aimed at crime prevention, crime control, and the enhancement of the criminal justice system; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Leandro Police Department (SLPD) submitted a request for grant funding through the County of Alameda for JAG funding to replace safety and communications equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the SLPD was awarded Department of Justice JAG grants in the amount of \$33,331, with an allocation of \$29,997.90 for the proposed project, \$999.93 (3%) set-aside for NIBRS implementation, and \$3,333.10 (10%) for administrative fees paid to the Alameda County Sheriff's Office for grant administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Leandro does RESOLVE as follows:

That the City Council accepts the grant funds and authorizes the City Manager or her designee to execute all documents related to the grant award of \$33,331; and

That an appropriation of \$29,997.90 in Account #150-21-053 is approved; and

That the balance of \$3,333.10 shall be reserved by and to the Alameda County Sheriff's Office for grant administration fees and not part of the City's share of the grant award.
