Land Use Element – Goal LU-3: Provide housing opportunities and improve economic access to housing for all segments of the community.

Land Use Element – Policy LU-3.1 Mix of Unit Types. Encourage a mix of residential development types in the city, including single family homes on a variety of lot sizes, as well as townhomes, row houses, live-work units, planned unit developments, garden apartments and medium to high density multi-family housing.

Land Use Element – Policy LU-3.3 Affordable Housing Design. Design new affordable housing to blend in with the existing fabric of the community. Affordable housing should be located in a variety of neighborhoods rather than concentrated in one particular part of the city.

Land Use Element – Policy LU-3.6 Housing by Non-Profit Developers. Promote the participation of non-profit housing organizations in the construction of new affordable housing in San Leandro, with particular emphasis on housing for working families.

Housing Element – Policy 1.4 Facilitate Infill Development. The City shall utilize infill development strategies to support neighborhoods and living environments that are served by public transit and services and are conducive to public health and wellness.

Housing Element – Goal 2: Assist the Development of Housing Affordable to Extremely Low-, Very Low-, Low-, and Moderate-Income Levels and populations with Special Needs

Housing Element – Policy 2.1 Promote Housing Development Affordable to Residents at All Economic Levels. The City shall support the production of rental and for-sale housing for people of all income levels.
