Proposed Process and Timeline

√	August 2021	City received Census 2020 redistricting data
√	January 26, 2022	City Council Rules Committee <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • review redistricting information • make recommendations re: redistricting criteria, process and timeline • discuss community outreach/noticing plan
√	February 7, 2022	Adoption of Timeline, Criteria and Outreach Plan for City Council Redistricting (reviews, discusses and adopts the criteria, timeline and community outreach plan for the 2020 Council redistricting)
√	February 12, 2022 February 15, 2022 February 17, 2022	Workshop Meetings to receive input on Draft District Maps
√	February 24, 2022	City Council Rules Committee <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • review Draft District Maps
→	March 7, 2022	City Council Public Hearing on final redistricting plan (ordinance passed to print)

	April 14, 2022	City submits final redistricting plan to Alameda County ROV

Current Criteria Consideration

- Population of districts as equal as possible
- Districts must consist of geographically compact contiguous territory
- District boundaries shall approximate election precinct boundaries established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda

Rules Committee meeting 1/26/2022 comments:

- During the redistricting process, don't take the existing Councilmembers out of their districts
- It is ok to have district populations on the lower end if housing projects are proposed to be built in that district
- Straighten boundaries where possible ex. Manor Blvd at Manor Branch Library
- Minor adjustment is ok

Community Meeting comments

- The Manor neighborhood is split between two districts but is a very large neighborhood.
- How did these boundaries get laid out originally, was it based on some historical bias, redlining?
- District boundaries would be more important if voting occurred within districts only.
- What are the significance of districts if they are voted at large and there is no money specifically allocated to specific districts for their needs?
- Consider large district boundary changes for the 2030 census.

Community Meeting recommendations

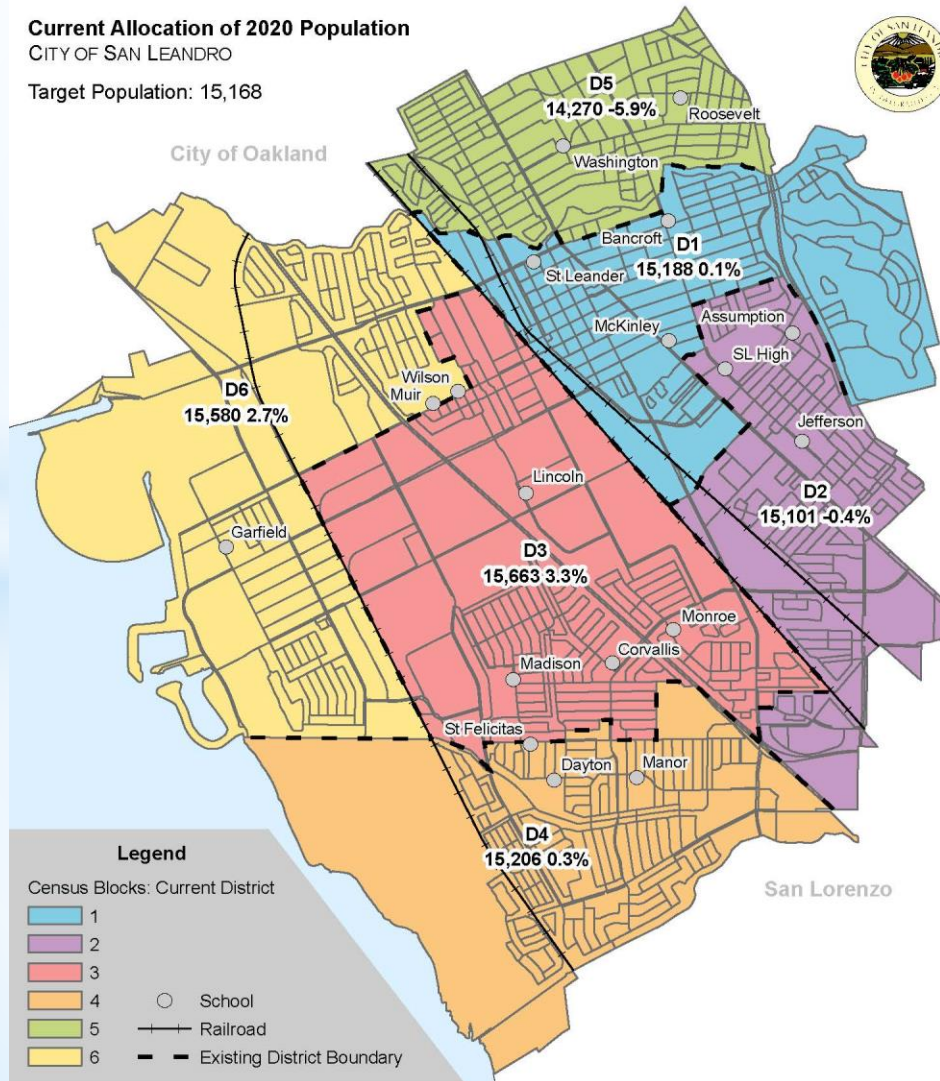
- ❑ Update boundaries to put industrial areas more evenly across districts instead of concentrating them in District 3 and 6. This can be looked at with the 2030 census.
- ❑ Move boundary between District 1 and 2 along Sybil Ave to the south of SLHS
- ❑ Move boundary between District 2 and 3 to Washington Ave
- ❑ Scenario 1 is the simplest change to meet the criteria outlined.

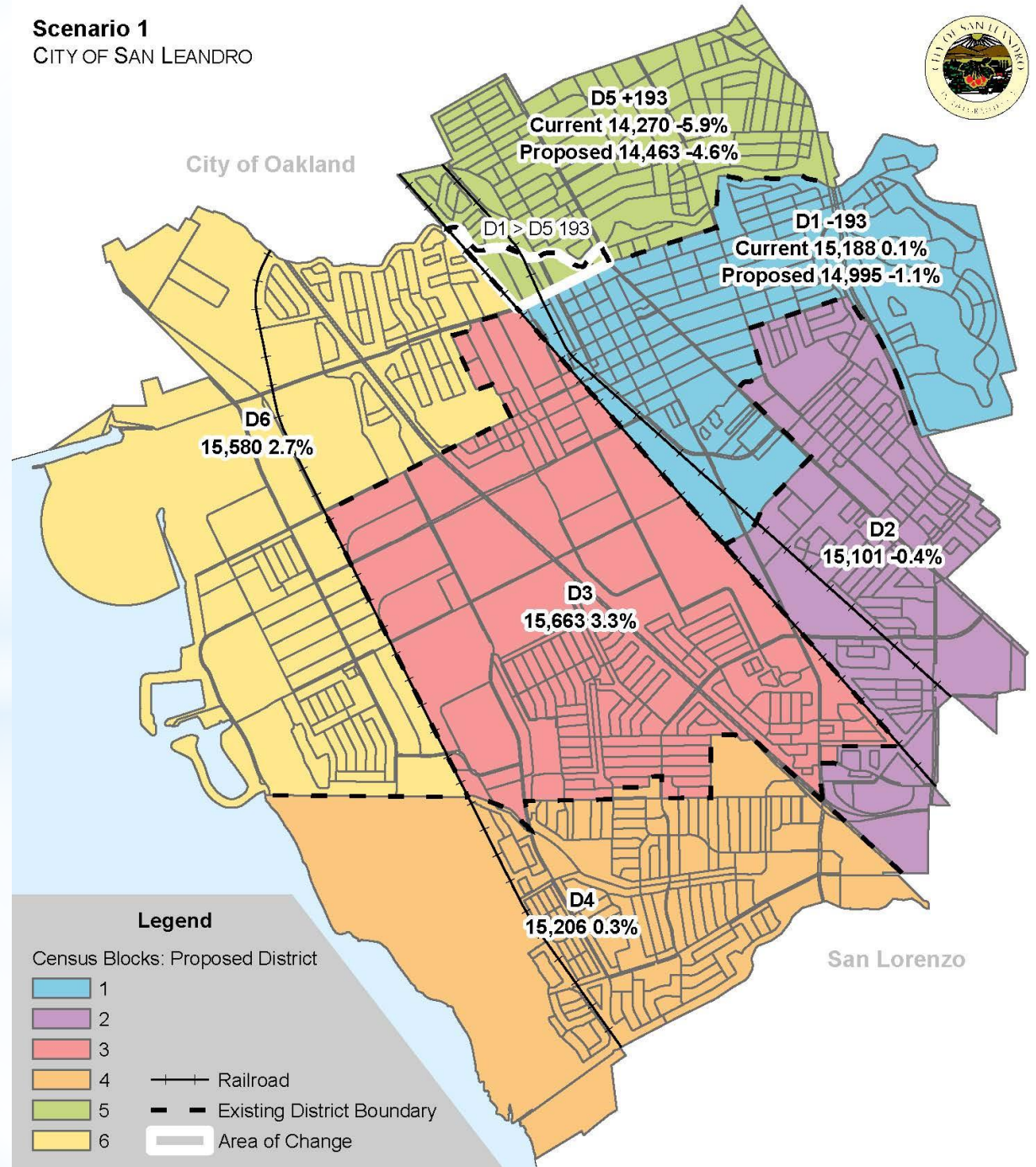

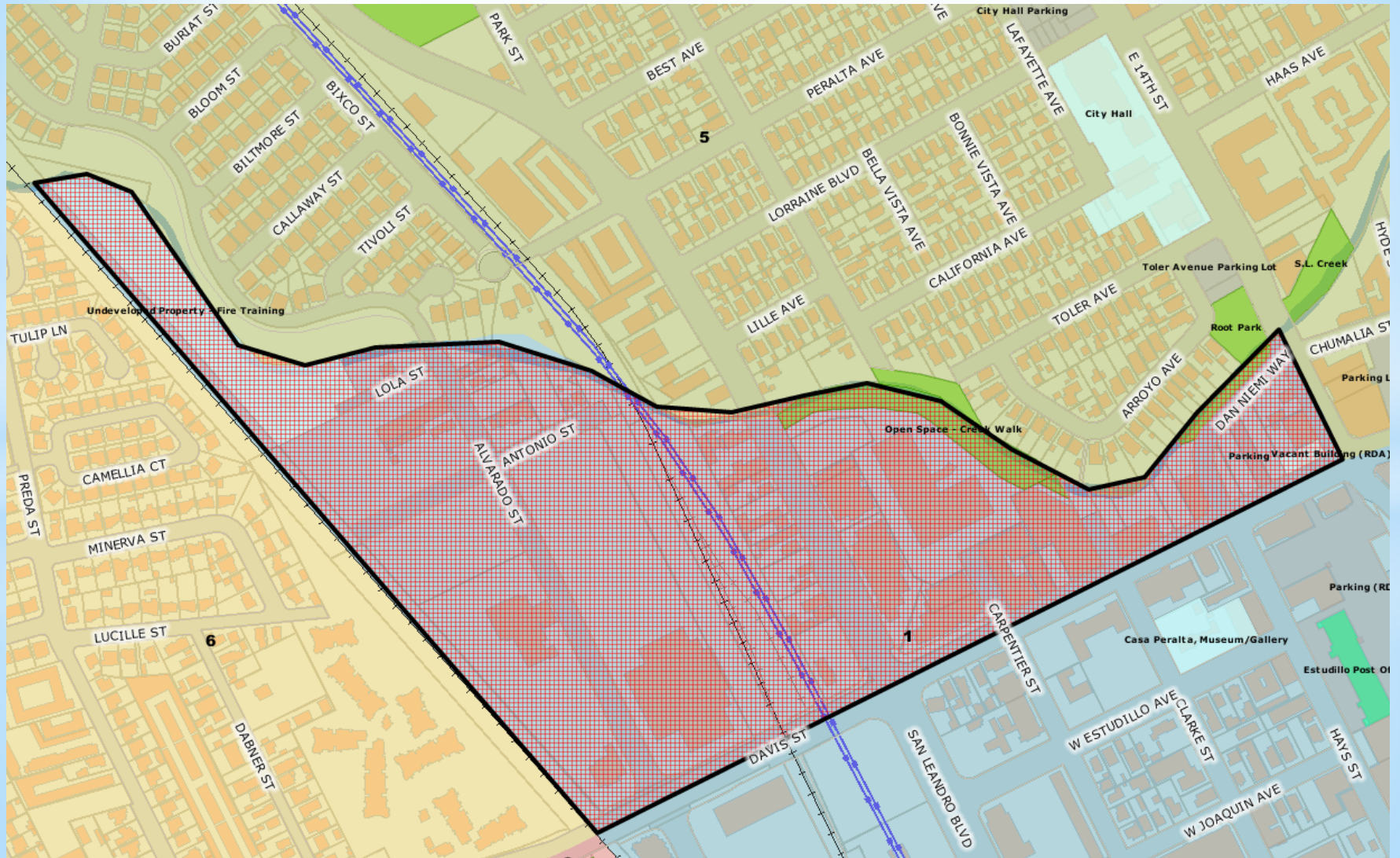
- positive values indicate districts need to gain population
