


### BRIEF HISTORY




- Construction 1901, significant alterations 1927-29 including addition of wall, tower, and fountain
- Deeded to the City 1971 as a "Community cultural, recreational, and historical center available for use by resident groups...."
- Described as a "Historic house museum" on the City website






2<sup>nd</sup> Floor
