8.A. Site Development Sub-Committee Appointment of One Board Member

Planning Manager Mogesen summarized the purpose of the Site Development Sub-Committee, which requires under the Zoning Code that the Mayor, Planning Commission and Board of Zoning Adjustments each nominate one of the three members constituting the Sub-Committee.

A Motion by Commissioner Collier ratifying the appointment of Commissioner Abero to the Site Development Sub-Committee for a two-year term through December 1, 2018. Seconded by Commissioner Hernandez.
