Key Characteristics of Effective Council Members (ILG)

- Successfully transition from candidate to a member of the council.
- Become a champion of the city. Make decisions based on the needs and interests of the community at-large / the greater good.
- *Develop, communicate and support* policy goals and council decisions.
- Demonstrate a willingness to work collaboratively (as a team) and take a citywide perspective.

In other words...

- Work well *together*.
- Set policy and priorities and then trust City Manager to align resources and get the important work done.
- Work productively with City Manager to reduce barriers to successful implementation of policy and achievement of priorities.
- Be supportive of City Staff as they work to attain the priorities that have been identified and agreed upon.

Can this be done in a way that *models leadership* and *builds confidence* in government and elected officials?

### Time Tested Leadership Behaviors\*





**Model the Way** 

**Enable Others To Act** 

Set the example by aligning actions with shared commitments.

Foster collaboration by building trust and facilitating relationships.

\*These are 2 of 5 Practices for Exemplary Leadership developed and time tested over more than 35 years by Jim Kouzes and Barry Posner as part of their work, "The Leadership Challenge"

#### Small Group Discussion (~10 minutes)

#### Team Commitments (from 2023)

- 1. Genuine, open dialogue
- 2. Willingness to get out of comfort zone
- 3. Don't villainize / do not support villainization
- 4. Genuinely consider both sides to understand underlying interest
- 5. Work toward a solution: something is better than nothing
- 6. Consider all constituents
- 7. Stay focused not every item requires comment
- 8. Trust the City Manager
- 9. Be prepared: read packets, prepare questions, help staff succeed
- 10. Practice a team mindset: share information, uplift others, be united
- 11. Commit to holding ourselves and each other accountable
- 12. Focus on the issue





#### Withdraw? Or defer?


