

East Bay Greenway Multimodal (Phase 1) (EBGWMM)

- Safer pedestrian and bicycle improvements along Alameda County high injury network
- Multimodal connectivity with new facilities in Equity Priority
 Communities
- 16 miles of regional trail/complete street facility
- Connects 7 BART stations from Lake Merritt to South Hayward








East Bay Greenway (Phase 1)- North Segment

Lake Merritt to Bayfair - Construction Packages














San Leandro Blvd – E 14th to Rose Dr






San Leandro Blvd - Coburn to Washington






San Leandro Blvd – Polar to Marina






San Leandro Blvd – Harlan to Thornton






San Leandro Blvd – Parrott to Estudillo








San Leandro Blvd – Siempre Verde Park to W Broadmoor






E 14th (State Route 185) Construction Package




E 14th – Bayfair Dr to Fairmont Dr



E 14th St – 152nd Ave to Hesperian / Bancroft




E 14th – Bancroft Ave to 147th Ave






$E 14^{th} St - 146^{th} Ave to 143^{rd} Ave$
