### San Leandro Municipal Code Proposed Changes

#### CHAPTER 6-1 TRAFFIC CONTROL

#### ARTICLE 8. MISCELLANEOUS

##### 6-1-825 PARKING AIDES.

- (a) The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to designate regularly employed and salaried employees of the Police Department as Parking Aides.
  - (b) Parking Aides shall enforce the provisions relating to regulation of traffic and to stopping, standing and parking of vehicles contained in Title VI of the San Leandro Municipal Code of 1957, the San Leandro Traffic Code and in the [Vehicle Code](#) of the State of California.
  - (c) Civilian employees of the City of San Leandro or independent contractors designated by the Chief of Police may enforce provisions of this title and the California Vehicle Code relating to the standing or parking of vehicles that legally may be enforced by persons other than peace officers.
- ~~—(e) Pursuant to the provisions of § 836.5 of the [Penal Code](#) of the State of California, an employee designated a Parking Aide is authorized to arrest a person without a warrant, or to issue a citation to such person, whenever such employee has reasonable cause to believe that the person has committed a misdemeanor or an infraction, in the presence of such employee, which is a violation of a statute or ordinance which, under the provisions of this section, such employee has the duty to enforce.~~
