Issued By The Mayor

Declaring March 18, 2022, as “San Leandro High School Drama Day” in San Leandro

WHEREAS, San Leandro High School’s Drama Department will present Disney’s “Beauty and the Beast” at the San Leandro Performing Arts Center on March 17th – 20th, directed by Allison Gamlen, with music direction by Kim Braun, and choreography by Dallis Wright-Morash; and

WHEREAS, “Beauty and the Beast” is a traditional French fairy tale about an arrogant prince, who has been transformed into a beast, and his beautiful captive, who discovers that real beauty comes from within; and

WHEREAS, the original tale was first published in 1740, and though it has been adapted through the centuries, its themes remain unchanged as its popularity grows; and

WHEREAS, the story offers humor, romance, and excitement for all ages; and

WHEREAS, this is the first performance that will be presented at San Leandro High School for two years, due to the COVID-19 lockdown. The 55 students who make up the cast and crew are excited to be back on stage; and

WHEREAS, San Leandro High School Drama Department normally produces a Fall play, a Spring musical, and a festival of One Acts each year; and

WHEREAS, the Drama Department offers a pre-professional training program with opportunities for all students to participate in full-scale, mainstage productions; and

WHEREAS, production experience is work-based learning that helps students to deepen their knowledge of industry standard approaches to performance and technical theater.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Pauline Russo Cutter, Mayor of the City of San Leandro, do hereby proclaim March 18, 2022, as “**San Leandro High School Drama Day**” in San Leandro and commend the department staff and students for their hard work on “Beauty and the Beast”.
