

New Building Upgrades




- LEED Silver Certified
- New Larger Building Increased from 1,200 SF up to 3,800 SF

- Optimal LED Lighting, Power and Heating and Cooling Systems

- Large Outdoor Gathering Area and Patio
- Comfortable variety of seating types








