RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE REALLOCATION OF PROJECTS FORMERLY FUNDED BY THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA)

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), providing a COVID-19 stimulus package delivering significant resources to state, local, territorial, and Tribal governments to support urgent COVID-19 response efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City developed a COVID-19 Recovery Plan for its \$18,600,000 allocation to provide needed resources to help residents and businesses recover from the combined health, social, and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, ARPA Funds must have been spent or obligated by December 31, 2024. If obligated, generally defined by the US Treasury as under contract, by December 31, 2024, public agencies have until December 31, 2026, to incur the costs. Funds that are not obligated by December 31, 2024 and subsequently spent by December 31, 2026 need to be returned to the US Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved reallocations of the previously unobligated amounts on December 9, 2024, temporarily defunding certain projects until a review of funding sources could be completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Leandro does RESOLVE as follows:

That \$805,204.15 is appropriated from the Capital Improvement Plan fund, and \$714,321 from the Measure BB fund as described and specified in the staff report associated with this Resolution; and

That the City Manager or her designee are authorized to take all actions and execute all documents necessary to effect the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
