- Health plan and social services – all combined



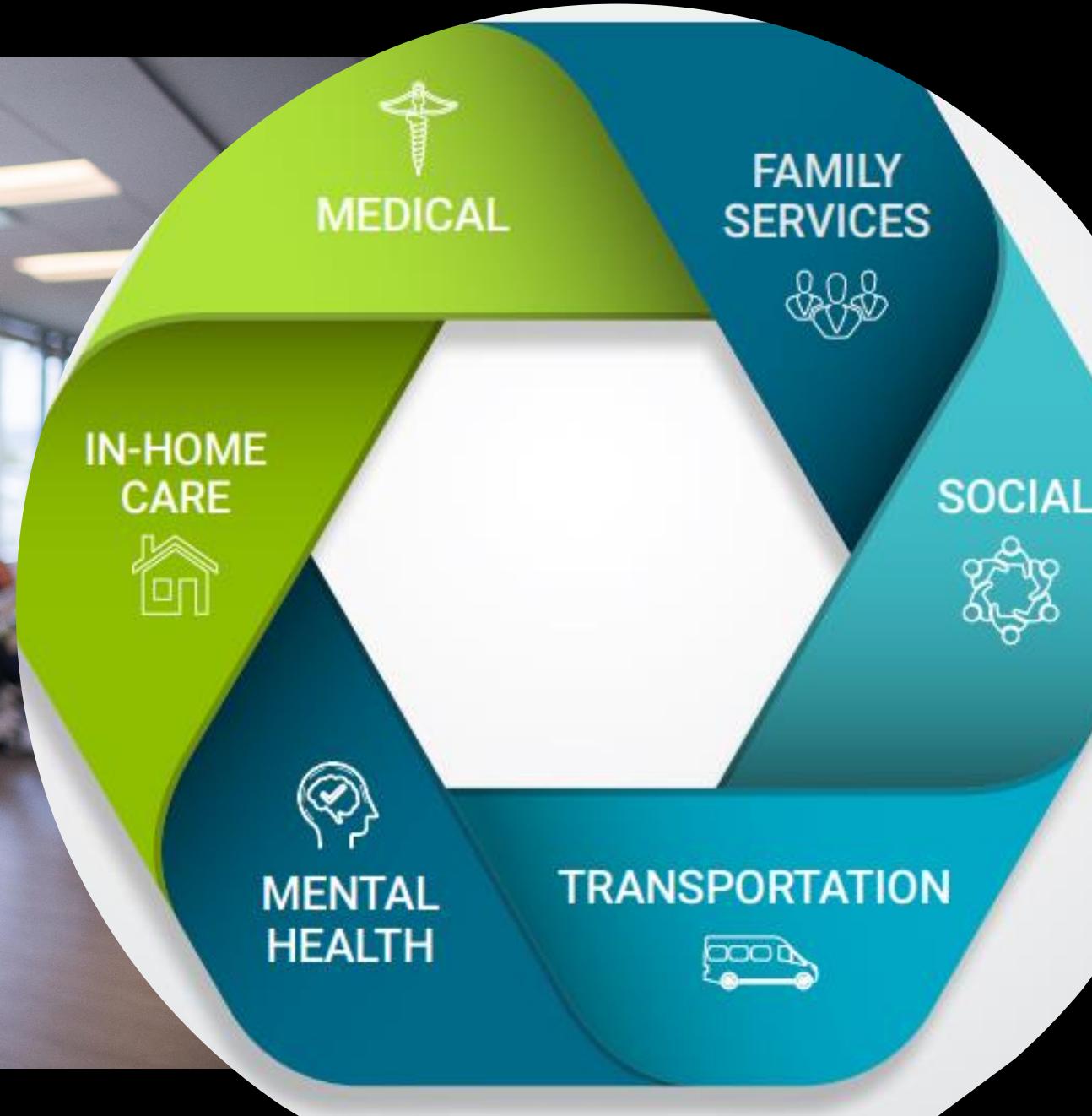


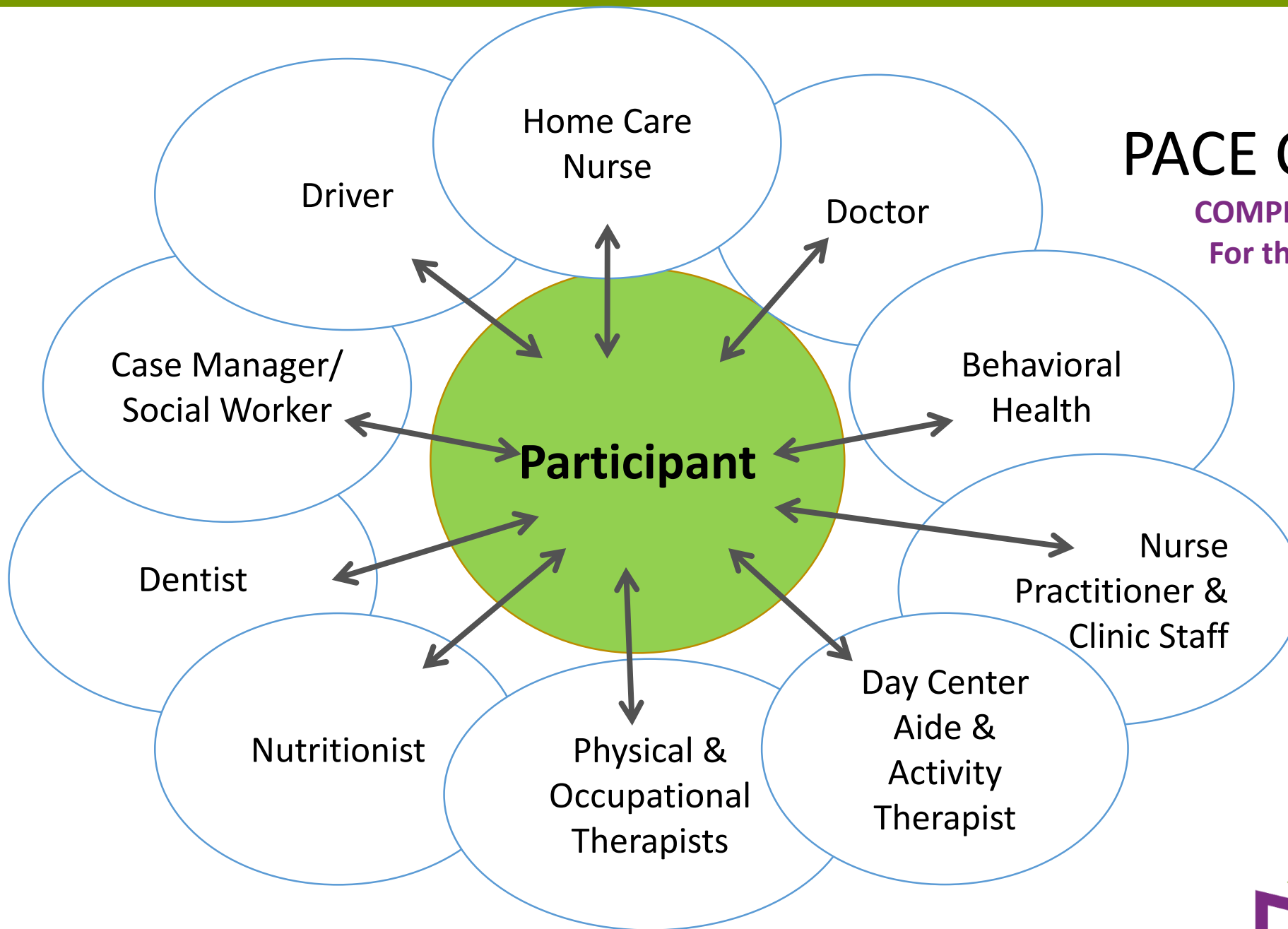
# PACE Healthcare is Different

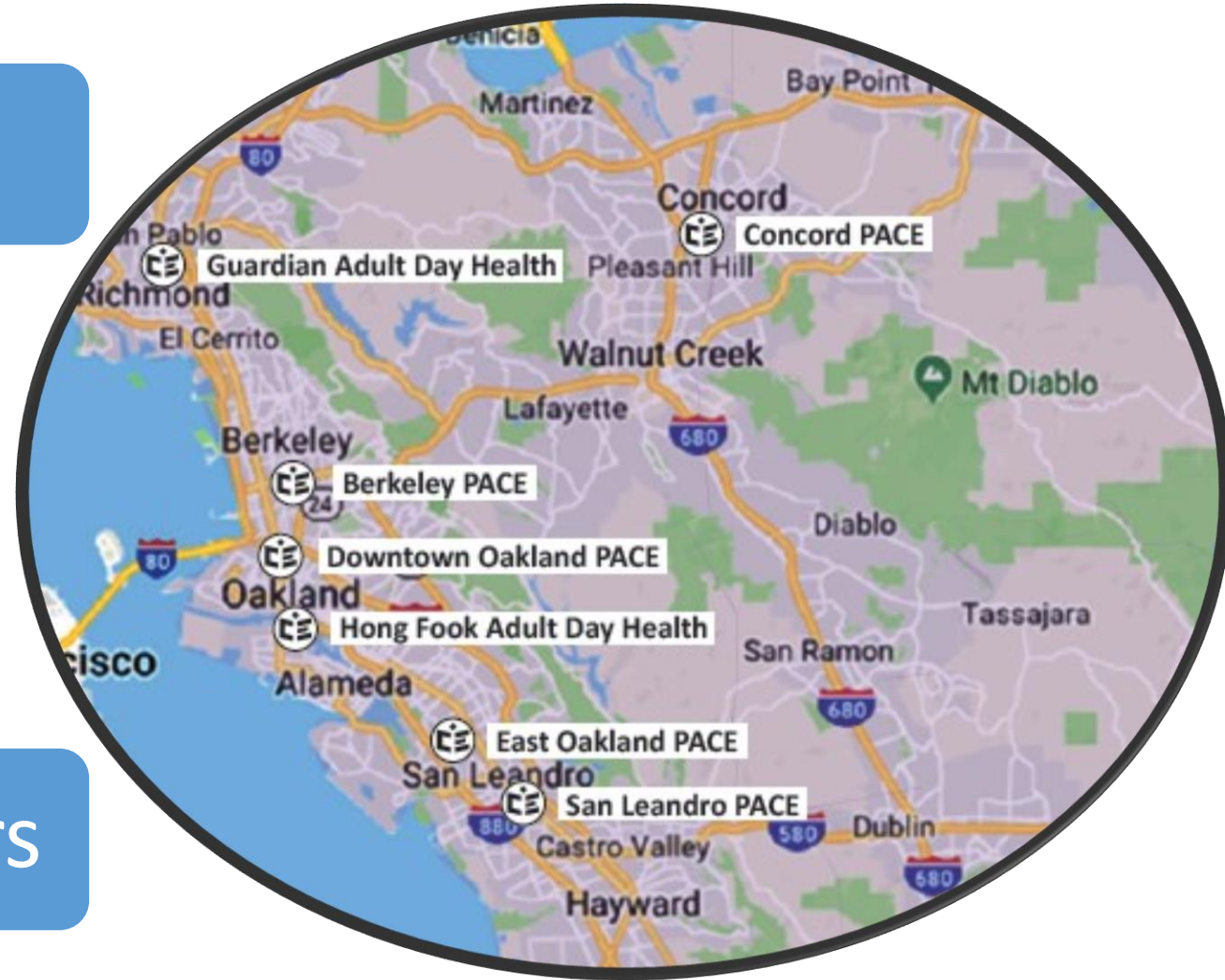

# Who is Eligible to Join?

- 55 years old and older
- Lives within Alameda or Contra Costa County
- Has housing and is safe to remain at home with PACE
- Deals with multiple health challenges
- Assessed by the CEI to require nursing home level of care (and certified by the CA Department of Health Services as such).





# CEI and COVID-19

## Vaccination is key

- 100% of staff
- 95% + of participants

## PACE centers are open

- Following CDC guidelines
- Hot meals served daily
- Telehealth and Zoom activities available
- In-person iPad Training Classes
- In-person fun group activities & exercise
- Reconnect or make new friends







# What Does This Cost?

- Care is reimbursed by Medicare and Medi-Cal
- If you have a Medi-Cal share of cost, you must pay that share of cost to CEI
- Families can also private pay
- No deductibles or Co-pays with Medi-Cal
- Members must use CEI doctors and contracted providers. Care outside of the CEI network is not covered.
