

## **General Fund Revenues**


#### **General Fund Revenues FY 2022-23 (\$M)**



## Sales Tax Per Capita









#### **Annual Unemployment Rate**







Over \$1.875M in Incentives and Grants from General Fund in past 10 Years

## **Commercial Relief Grants**

#### **ARPA Funds - \$750,000**

- □ Rent Relief Grants Complete over \$372,000
  - 32 Grants provided to biz up to \$15,000 grants for back rent
  - Support continued operations after end of Eviction Moratorium
- Facility Improvement Program underway
  - Up to \$45,000 for physical improvements
  - First Phase Outdoor Dining
  - Future Phases may include:
    - aesthetic/façade improvements
    - ADA upgrades
    - replacement of damaged facilities
    - environmental design elements to improve security



## **Technical Assistance**

#### **ARPA Funds - \$225,000**

- Monthly Business Webinars ongoing
  - Building/Planning Permit Process, Safe Business Practices, ADA Compliance, etc.
- Technical Assistance Workplan & Implementation ongoing
  - Develop Programs that can be continued in future
  - Enhance Partnerships with TA & Educational Providers
    - More Assistance for SL Businesses
  - Provide one-on-one and group assistance in areas such as:
    - Adapting business models to changing customer demand

    - Financial training and access to capital


