PRIDE MONTH & LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER AND QUESTIONING/QUEER (LGBTQ) SENIOR SAFE, VISIBLE AND CELEBRATED MONTH

WHEREAS, San Leandro is proudly one of the most diverse communities in California and the founding city of the Lavender Seniors of the East Bay; and

WHEREAS, San Leandro's diversity includes many Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Questioning/Queer (LGBTQ) individuals, couples, seniors, and their children and families; and

WHEREAS, many LGBTQ residents and seniors have provided decades of hard work to organize their communities, taking risks and making many sacrifices to pave the way for the civil rights we enjoy today; and

WHEREAS, the Lavender Seniors of the East Bay has been at the forefront in providing advocacy and education to promote broader understanding of diversity in the LGBTQ community, and helping to establish greater safety and services for seniors, youth, and other residents; and
