Annual Street Sealing 2018-19 (\$3.3M)

San Leandro City streets are organized into four asphalt concrete (AC) maintenance areas. This 2019 project will apply preservation surface treatments to a number of streets in north-western quadrant of the City. Streets in this quadrant, that are not overly distressed, were evaluated and selected for the appropriate preservation application. Treatments include slurry seal, asphalt rubber chip seal, and micro-surfacing.

The project will also upgrade curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards



Construction is scheduled for summer 2019. This project will treat a total of 19.0 lane miles of roadway.

This project was made possible with the following funding:- SB-1, Gas Tax, CalRecycle grant, and Measure B/BB funds.
