#### 2. DISCUSSION ITEMS

## **2.A.** 20-478 Update on Laws and Regulations Related to Tobacco Retailers

Eric Engelbert, Deputy City Manager and Andrew Mogensen, Planning Manager presented the item and responded to questions from the Committee members.

## RULES COMMITTEE COMMENTS:

- a. The Committee requested that an ordinance revision impose a CAP on the total number of TRLs that could be issued by the city.
- b. The Committee supports a ban on tobacco sales at pharmacies.
- c. The Committee supports a ban of the issuance on TRLs in proximity to schools.
- d. The Committee requested further discussion into point of sale requirements and an assessment of the cost to retailers.
- e. The Committee requested all public within 1000-foot proximity be notified for future meetings.

Public Comment was received from Paul Sekhon.

The outstanding discussion will be brought back to the Rules Committee with a draft ordinance revision to the existing ordinance.

#### **2.B.** 20-452 Discussion of Business Hours for Alcohol Sales

Eric Engelbert, Deputy City Manager and Andrew Mogensen, Planning Manager presented the item and responded to questions from the Committee members.

- a. The Committee requested the staff look into additional options to address the problem areas.
- b. The Committee supports working with the Police Chief to place these areas on his radar.
