



BENEFIT DISTRICTS 101 Their legal basis and purpose.

- City of San Leandro Community Benefit District Ordinance Title 2, Chapter 2-20 (under Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994).
- To provide ENHANCED services (above and beyond City's GENERAL services) in a specific area.
- Enhancements can include additional cleaning, security, district marketing, etc.
- Requires petition by 30% of weighted property owners (representing 30% of the total assessments to be collected).
- District terms can vary from 5 20 years.

 Managed by a non-profit, governed by Management and Disbursement Agreement with City of San Leandro.


