

## FY 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan CDBG Highlights

- > FY 2021-22 notification of allocation received in early March:
  - > Total available for allocation: \$1,234,998
    - > CDBG FY 2021-22: \$763,357
    - > Unallocated in FY 2020-21: \$408,811
    - Unspent in FY 2019-20: \$37,830
    - > Program Income collected in FY 2020-21: \$25,000
  - ➤ Total available for allocation: \$344,237
    - ➤ HOME FY 2021-22: \$224,884 (includes \$12,918 that covers City staff costs)
    - ➤ HOME FY 2020-21 (portion of allocation unspent): \$132,271

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

- > Staff returns to Council in June 2021 with contracts for the CDBG-funded FY 2021-2022 grant allocations
  - ✓ Effective: July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022
- > Staff submits Final Annual Action Plan to HUD May 14, 2021
