UNITED AGAINST HATE WEEK

WHEREAS, the United States is a nation of immigrants, whose strength comes from its Diversity; and

WHEREAS, United Against Hate Week calls for local civic action by residents of every Bay Area community to stop the hate and implicit biases that are a dangerous threat to the safety and civility of neighborhoods, towns, and cities; and

WHEREAS, civic leaders directly respond to expressions of hate in communities and empower residents to take action to alter the course of intolerance; and

WHEREAS, the number of hate crimes committed across the United States each year continues to be a subject matter of significant ongoing public concern; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Leandro is deeply committed to inclusivity and promotes a hate-free environment that fosters a safe and flourishing community; and

WHEREAS, education, compassion, and cooperation are key to understanding and embracing differences between people, and the recognition of United Against Hate week will further state our shared values and reiterate our commitment to inclusivity.
