- Commissioner Zuber visited the dog park and commented on how it looked great. She also reported that she observed large gatherings at Marina Park, despite the county order prohibiting them.

- Commissioner Bolar reported that McCartney Park gate was opened by the San Leandro School District and that the park is now open.

- Commissioner Wagner reported that the parks he visited looked beautiful. He also reported that he noticed that the small parking lot at Bonaire Park is closed and that there are woodchips that are piling up in the park.

**5.B PARK AND OPEN SPACE OPERATION AND MAINTAINANCE REPORT - JENNIFER AULETTA, PUBLIC WORKS DEPUTY DIRECTOR****B. Park and Open Space Operation and Maintenance**

- Deputy Public Works Director Jennifer Auletta updated the commission regarding ongoing projects in city parks.
- Park maintenance staff are now working 4 days a week.
- Most park restrooms are closed, with the exemption of the park restrooms listed in the last meeting.  
The Chabot Park restroom was opened when Chabot Camps started, and a new water fountain was installed.
- Athletic fields will remain closed and the gates will remain locked.
- Tennis courts and the dog park are now open for use.
- The staff is working on the design for replacing the irrigation well at Manor Park, resurfacing of the city tennis courts and the water drainage at Bonaire Park.
- Part of the tennis court resurfacing design includes converting two tennis courts into pickleball courts at Washington Manor Park
